



International Society for Burn Injuries Nursing Award Sponsored by Professor Mehmet Haberal

The Baskent University Nursing Award recognizes 3 outstanding nurses from developing countries who have made significant contributions to the quality of nursing care for patients with burn injuries. Recognition for this achievement can be through clinical practice, research, and clinical and/or academic teaching.

Eligibility:

To apply for the Award, applicants must meet ALL of the following conditions:

- Must be an active ISBI member (paid annual membership dues) and has maintained an active membership for a minimum of one year, not including the year of the congress.
- The applicant must be from a low-income country as defined by the ISBI membership categories.
- Applicants for the award must submit an abstract for an oral presentation at the biennial congress of the ISBI.
- Selected applicants must be listed as the first author on the abstract and must present it in person at the biennial ISBI congress to deliver the presentation of their abstract.
- Applicants who have previously received this award are not eligible to receive this award in consecutive congresses.

Application:

- The applicant must indicate their intention to apply for the award when submitting abstracts for the biennial ISBI Congress on the online **abstract submission portal**.
- The applicant must also send a notification of abstract submission including abstract title, declare any conflict of interest including grants, travel expenses and registration fees.
- A copy of the applicant's Curriculum Vitae (CV) illustrating previous work, contributions and recognitions in burn nursing is required.
- All required documents must be sent electronically to info@worldburn.org and must be received by June 1, the year of the ISBI Congress.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Selection Process:

The submitted abstract(s) will be assessed and scored by a panel of experts. The entire application will then be reviewed to determine if all application criteria have been met. Those abstracts selected will be allocated to a specific session for presentation during the congress.

Award Announcement:

The Nursing Awards will be announced at the biennial congress during the General Assembly. The 3 successful applicants will receive \$1,000 USD and a certificate.
