



**International Society for Burn Injuries
Young Investigator Award
Sponsored by Professor Naoki Aikawa**

Purpose:

The Young Investigator Award is established to promote the activities of the International Society for Burn Injuries (ISBI) by encouraging and motivating young ISBI members from developing countries to conduct clinical research and work on burn prevention initiatives.

The Award:

At the biennial ISBI Congress, total of six investigators will be awarded one of the following prizes:

Gold Prize; Physician Category: \$2,000.00 USD and a Certificate

Gold Prize; Non-Physician Category: \$2,000.00 USD and a Certificate

Silver Prize; Physician Category: \$ 1,500.00 USD and a Certificate

Silver Prize; Non-Physician Category: \$1,500.00 USD and a Certificate

Bronze Prize; Physician Category: \$ 500.00 USD and a Certificate

Bronze Prize; Non-Physician Category: \$ 500.00 USD and a Certificate

***** Physician submissions must be for oral presentations. Non physician submissions may be either for oral or poster submissions. All submitted abstracts must demonstrate research activity.**

Eligibility:

To apply for the Award, applicants must meet ALL of the following conditions:

1. Must be an active ISBI member (paid annual membership dues) and has maintained an active membership for a minimum of one year not including the year of the congress. The applicant must be from a low-income country as defined by the ISBI membership categories.
2. Must be under the age of 40 years on the opening day of the biennial ISBI Congress.
3. Must be the first author of a paper/poster (as per the categories above) and present it in person during the biennial ISBI Congress.

Application:

Please complete the application and submit electronically along with a copy of your abstract and your CV to office@worldburn.org.

Please note: The applicant must indicate their intention to apply for the award when submitting abstracts for the biennial ISBI Congress.

Selection Process:

The submitted abstract(s) will be assessed and scored by a panel of experts. The entire application will then be reviewed to determine if all application criteria have been met. Those abstracts selected will be allocated to a specific session for presentation during the congress.

Award Announcement:

The Young Investigator Awards will be announced at the Biennial ISBI Congress during the General Assembly.
