VERGINA - The Royal Tombs


Vergina, identified with ancient Aigai, listed as a World Heritage site, was the first capital of ancient Macedonia, where Phillip II, father of Alexander the Great was assassinated, and Alexander was proclaimed king. The today small village became world known due to the discovery of the Royal Tombs and especially that of Philip II, as there, was supposed to be the burial place of the Macedonian Kings.

The underground museum exhibiting Phillip's grave and its contents, truly fit for a king, is one of the most remarkable archaeological displays in Europe.

Feast your eyes on the marvelous treasures; all masterpieces of ancient Greek art dated back to the 4th century B.C., such as golden wreaths, silver vessels, miniature sculpture, paintings etc.

Continue to Yianakohori and visit Kir Yianni traditional winery, founded in 1997 by Yiannis Boutaris, one of the leading figures in the Greek wine industry. Today, Stellios Boutaris, member of the fifth generation of winemakers, leads Kir-Yianni into the next phase of its history, by dynamically exploiting the cornerstones of the Kir-Yianni philosophy: desire for innovation, respect for tradition and true knowledge of the wine, from the grape to the end consumer. Join the guided tour to the winery, watch the winemaking process, see the cellars and taste three of the most legendary wines of Xinomavro, the local variety.
